Prayers

Your child should know by heart the following prayers:
Hail Mary Our Father The Glory Be Act of Contrition

Prayer is *talking* and *listening* to God

Sacraments

There are 7 sacraments. They are:

<i>Baptism</i>	We become members of God's family
<i>Reconciliation</i> Or <i>Penance</i> Or <i>Confession</i>	We tell God we are sorry and God forgives our sins
<i>Eucharist</i> Or <i>Communion</i>	We receive the Body and Blood of Jesus
<i>Confirmation</i>	When the Holy Spirit comes to us in a special way
<i>Matrimony</i>	When a man and a woman get married and promise to live together for life
<i>Holy Orders</i>	When a man becomes a priest
<i>Anointing of the Sick</i>	When the sick receive a blessing with holy oil

The **Blessed Trinity** is God:

The Father	The Son	The Holy Spirit

Jesus

- Jesus is the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity.
- Jesus became human when He was born on Christmas.

At Mass	We hear God's word in the Gospel
	The priest changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus
	Receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Communion

The *Ten Commandments* show us how to love God, ourselves and one another.



Love God with all your heart.

You must love others as yourself.



Sin is when you choose to do what is wrong.

You *examine your conscience* to get ready for the Sacrament of Reconciliation also called Penance or Confession.

God always *forgives* us if we are sorry for the things we have done wrong.



Advent – Time when we prepare for Christmas

Christmas – Day Jesus was born and became human

Lent – Time when we prepare for Easter

Easter – Day Jesus rose from the dead
