1. Please note well the mass times on December 23, 24, 30, 31 and January 1. Christmas Eve and New Years Eve both fall on a Sunday this year, so there are separate obligations for Sunday and Christmas and New Years Eve:
 - a. **December 23/24 Sunday Obligation**: 4:30 PM on 12/23 and 8:00 AM/10 AM on 12/24 - no 5:30 PM on 12/24 for Sunday Obligation
 - b. **December 24/25 Christmas Obligation**: 4:30 PM(two masses - Hall & Church) on 12/24 and 8 AM/10AM on 12/25. ***The 4:30 PM on 12/24 only satisfies the Christmas Holyday obligation not the Sunday obligation.***
 - c. **December 30/31 Sunday Obligation**: 4:30 PM mass on 12/30 and 8:00 AM/10:00 AM mass on 12/31
 - d. **December 31/January 1**: Solemnity of Mary Feast Day - mass at 5:30 PM on 12/31 and 10:00 AM on 1/1. ***Since the feast day falls on a Monday, it is technicality not a Holy Day of Obligation but the mass at 5:30 PM on 12/31 will be the Liturgy for the Feast Day on 1/1 and not for Sunday.***
2. Please make sure you meet your assignments or get someone to replace you if you cannot make an assignment. The priests/deacons at mass and homebound and residents at Brightview are counting on you being there.
3. The schedule is getting more challenging each time and I try to take all your needs into account but if I mess up just let me know and I will try and fix it.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion –

1. **All EMHCs -**
 - a. There will always be a Silver Ciborium in the Tabernacle that is to be used for Homebound and Brightview EMHCs to use to get hosts to take to the Homebound and Brightview residents. Do not use this Silver Ciborium for distribution of communion at mass unless absolutely necessary. Deacon Joe will ensure that the Silver Ciborium is adequately filled with consecrated hosts after the 7 am masses on Friday for use by the Homebound and Brightview EMHCs.
 - b. It has been difficult on some weekends to assign people to the 5:30 PM mass on Sunday. If you see a "TBD" for 5:30 PM Mass, no one was assigned. If you happen to attend that mass and are not assigned please support the priest and Deacon by going up to distribute communion.
2. **On Going reminders -**
 - a. **Numbers next to Homebound EMHCs** – these numbers are a reference to the Homebound Lists (List 1, List 2) which I email you. You should always have a copy of both lists and just go the people on the List assigned to you for that weekend.
 - b. **Brightview-Union Mill Ministry -**
 - i. The Sacristy Door will be left open at the end of the 10 am mass to give the Brightview-Union Mill or Brightview Greentree EMHCs the opportunity to secure left over consecrated hosts in the Tabernacle and put away materials that they use at Brightview in the Sacristy. Upon returning all items, the Brightview EMHCs should close and lock the Sacristy Door unless there is a priest/deacon in need of access, in which case remind them to secure the door when they are leaving.

- ii. Deacon Tom is no longer supporting Brightview-Union Mill. Deacon Tom has taken on some additional responsibilities for the Diocese to support Joint Base McGuire/Dix/Lakehurst on weekends and will not be able to support Brightview on Sunday mornings. Therefore, assigned Brightview-Union Mill EMHCs will have the responsibility to do the complete Communion Service at Brightview, as we used to do before Deacon Tom started helping us.

Christmas Novena - There will be a Christmas Novena from December 4th through December 12th consisting of mass and a reflection. The mass will occur at 7 pm each day of the Novena and this mass is in addition to any regularly scheduled masses for that day. The Novena mass on 12/7 and 12/8 fulfills the Immaculate Conception Holy Day and the Novena Mass on 12/9 and 12/10 fulfills the Sunday obligation. I have asked for Lectors to volunteer to support the Novena and below is a schedule for those Lectors who have volunteered for this 7 pm mass:

New EMHCs - We have two new EMHCs that will be supporting the Homebound ministry starting mid February 2018 after they go through some training. Marian and Laura Mote will be a mother/daughter team that will be supporting the Homebound. Please welcome them to our EMHC Ministry.

I plan to put out the next schedule by 3 March 2018, and it will cover the period from 17 March to 10 June 2018 (includes Holy Week and Easter).
