1. **Need EMs and Lectors** - we have lost 2 EMs and 2 Lectors, who have moved in the last month. If you know of anyone that would like to become an EM or Lector, please encourage them to do so and send me their name and phone number.
2. **Meetings** - We will be having meetings in October for all EMs and a separate meeting for all Lectors. Currently I am targeting 11 October for EMs and 12 October for Lectors but I will firm that up and send out an email within the next week.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion –**

1. **Tabernacle Key** - The Tabernacle Key is now being secured in a Lockbox in the cabinet in the Sacristy. The combination to the Lockbox is known to the priests, deacons and the Homebound and Brightview EMs. The key should be secured at the end of each mass in the Lockbox by the Deacon or the Priest. If you see the key on the table behind the altar or still attached to the Tabernacle at the end of mass, please remind the Deacon or the Priest to secure the key.
2. **Brightview-Union Mill Ministry** -
  - a. The Sacristy Door will be left open at the end of the 10 am mass to give the Brightview-Union Mill or Brightview Greentree EMs the opportunity to secure left over consecrated hosts in the Tabernacle and put away materials that they use at Brightview in the Sacristy. Upon returning all items, the Brightview EMs should close and lock the Sacristy Door unless there is a priest/deacon in need of access, in which case remind them to secure the door when they are leaving.
  - b. Deacon Tom is no longer supporting Brightview Union Mill. Deacon Tom has taken on some additional responsibilities for the Diocese to support Joint Base McGuire/Dix/Lakehurst on weekends and will not be able to support Brightview on Sunday mornings. Therefore, assigned Brightview Union Mill EMs will have the responsibility to do the complete Communion Service at Brightview, as we used to do before Deacon Tom started helping us.
3. **Scheduling** - Scheduling continues to be a bit of a challenge. The largest challenge is still the 5:30 pm mass on Sunday evening. There are some weekends where it was not possible to schedule anyone (based on people's availability that I have received) and that was indicated by a TBD. And since this mass typically does not have a Deacon, it could only be the priest. So, if you happen to attend this mass and you are not scheduled, be prepared to help out. Likewise, if you are not scheduled for anything on the weekends where the 5:30 pm mass has a TBD for EMs, consider attending that mass, if you can.
4. **On Going reminders** -
  - a. **Numbers next to Homebound EMs** – these numbers are a reference to the Homebound Lists (List 1, List 2) which I email you. You should always have a copy of both lists and just go the people on the List assigned to you for that weekend.
  - b. **Handicap Distribution of Communion** - In addition to the current three pews that are reserved for the Handicapped in the front, tabernacle side of the church, two additional pews are reserved in the back of the church on the same side - the last two pews in the back, closest to the back doors/foyer. EMs will distribute communion to

both these sections during the normal communion distribution part of the mass using the following process:

- i. The EM who is the first to receive the Ciborium from the Priest or Deacon should go to the Tabernacle side *immediately* (**DO NOT WAIT FOR THE OTHER EMs OR THE PRIEST TO START DISTRIBUTION**) to the back of the church and go directly to the Reserved Pews in the back of the church first and provide communion to the people located in those pews. Please use the aisle closest to the side doors to get to the back. If you get to the back pews or near them and see no one in those pews, turn around and go back to the front pews.
- ii. After distributing communion to the back Reserved Pews, proceed to the front of the church (again along the side aisle closet to the side doors) and provide communion to those people in the Reserved Front pews next.
- iii. After distributing communion to the Front Reserved pews, position yourself as you normally would to provide communion to the remaining communicants as they process up to the front from the Tabernacle side pews.

I plan to put out the next schedule by 25 November 2017, and it will cover the period from 9 December 2017 to 11 March 2018 (Christmas and start of Lent).
