In response to the sexual abuse crisis engulfing the Catholic Church at this time, the parish family of both St. John Neumann and St. Isaac Jogues will be having Eucharistic Adoration, opportunities for confession and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for six consecutive Fridays beginning on September 14, 2018, which is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, and for the next six weeks on Fridays ending on Oct. 19th, The Feast of Saint Isaac Jogues.

Let us come and join together in Christ and pray for reparation for sins committed against the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Let us pray for healing for the victims and survivors of the sexual abuse of minors and vulnerable adults by some clergy; to beg pardon for the failures of Bishops and Church authorities for any attempt on their part to cover up these atrocities and crimes; to ask that God might give the whole church including our Diocese the healing grace to place our faith, hope and trust back in Our God.
